COUNTDOWN TO LENT: Ash Wednesday is coming! Lent begins this Wednesday! What is the meaning of this season and our preparations?

The Church prepares us to enter into the celebration of Easter (the supreme solemnity of the liturgical year) by six weeks of conversion and renewal. Lent is a time when Jesus wants to renew all members of the people of God. Two words describe the Lenten Season clearly: it is baptismal and penitential.

Lent is centred on Baptism. For us who have been baptized into Christ, it is a time for renewing out baptismal covenant. We are to continue to die with Christ to sin and to live with Him for God. This renewal (which is an all-year and lifelong task) is emphasized in a special way during Lent.

Lent is also a period of repenting and doing penance. It is a time when Jesus calls us to be serious in living out our baptismal promises. We are called to root our sin from our lives and to turn back to the ways of Jesus Christ. We are invited to fast and do penance as part of our daily carrying of the cross. Finally, we are encouraged to build up God's kingdom by placing God's will at the centre of our lives.

How will Lent be different this year in your life? Now is the time to begin planning your personal lenten program of prayer, repentance and change of heart.
