
VOTIVE CANDLES are available to be lit at the entrance of the Church. Please see the minister of hospitality for one. Cost is \$5.00 per candle.

PILGRIMAGE OF THE RELICS OF THE CANADIAN MARTYRS AND ST. KATERI TEKAKWITHA

On **Sunday, January 18th** we will welcome these sacred relics at the Cathedral. The 9:00 A.M. Mass will be celebrated by Fr. John O'Brien, SJ, Rector of the National Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs in Midland. He will give a homily on these great figures in the sacred history of our country. After Mass, the Cathedral will be open from **10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.** so that the faithful can come and pray before these relics.

The Canadian Martyrs (St. Jean de Brébeuf, St. Isaac Jogues, St. Gabriel Lalemant, St. Noel Chabanel, St. Charles Garnier, St. Antoine Daniel, St. René Goupil, and St. Jean de la Lande) came to bring the Gospel to our country and bore witness to their faith at the cost of their lives. They are the secondary patrons of Canada and as such they deserve our admiration and invite us to imitate them in our mission to proclaim Christ through our daily lives.

St. Kateri Tekakwitha was one of the first Indigenous people to convert to the Christian Faith; she surely intercedes for our Indigenous brothers and sisters. as suggested by the large icon representing her in the Cathedral.




WHAT IS THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY ABOUT?: The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee.

In the magi, representatives of the neighbouring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation.

The magi's coming to Jerusalem in order to pay homage to the king of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations.

Their coming means that pagans can discover Jesus and worship him as Son of God and Saviour of the world only by turning towards the Jews and receiving from them the messianic promise as contained in the Old Testament.

The Epiphany shows that "the full number of the nations" now takes its "place in the family of the patriarchs", and acquires *Israelitica dignitas* (is made "worthy of the heritage of Israel") [CCC 528].
